

# NeighborWoods Program



Organized in Tulsa by **Up With Trees**

Planting, Preserving & Promoting Tulsa's Urban Forest.



- What is it?*** An Up With Trees program allowing neighborhood groups to receive one free tree per homeowner who desires one in their front yard.
- Who plants?*** Volunteers from the community, Up With Trees staff, neighbors & homeowners who are receiving trees. If a homeowner is unable to plant, they are encouraged to help in other ways -- by bringing snacks & beverages to the planting day kick-off.
- Where?*** Within the City of Tulsa at this time. We hope to expand the program to surrounding areas once we reach our "ReGreen Tulsa" matching grant goal.
- When?*** NeighborWoods plantings take place during planting season (October through April) on Saturday mornings. Up With Trees will schedule a planting date for your neighborhood upon receipt of your application.
- Which trees?*** Homeowners select their preference from a wide list of available trees, including shade, ornamental and evergreen trees.
- How do I participate?*** Obtain an application online or by calling the Up With Trees office. A representative from the neighborhood group must fill out one application for the entire area, and then coordinate delivery and collection of approval forms from individual homeowners.
