
We want to extend our thanks to your organization and the Apache Foundation for the trees we received on April 11, 2009.

The trees were planted in the Webbers Falls Veterans Memorial Park and at the Juliette Taylor Cemetery, Muskogee County, Webbers Falls, OK. We are presently repairing the Memorial and believe the trees will be in beautiful blooms next Spring.

The Cemetery is a very old country cemetery that charges no fees and is maintained by volunteers. It was the site of the Stagecoach Inn owned by Judge Samuel McDaniel Taylor and his wife, the former Juliette Vann. It was the main stop for travelers from Ft. Smith going to Muskogee and vice versa. Juliette was known for taking in orphan children and raising them. This was her land allotment from the Dawes Commission. She set aside land for the Cemetery. She and the Judge are both buried here.

I have enclosed some photographs for you to use as you wish. Again we thank you for the trees and hope they remain beautiful for many years to come.
