**HEIGHT**

30 - 60'

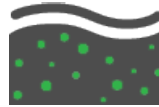
**SPREAD**

20 - 40'



**SUNLIGHT**

Full sun; meaning it should get at least six hours of direct, unfiltered sunlight each day.



**SOIL**

Prefers a moist soil, but tolerant of wet and dry soils, high pH and summer heat.



**ATTRIBUTES**

- Produces no sawtimber, pulpwood, or utility poles.
- Has been planted in greater numbers than almost any other tree species in North America.
- Heartwood, bark, and roots contain many extractives of actual and potential value in food processing, pesticide manufacturing and dyemaking.
- Used in landscape design, being picturesque rather than beautiful, possessing strong form, texture and character.



**POTENTIAL PROBLEMS**

Fruits are the size of softballs, hard as a rock and not edible for human consumption.
